

HOLY NAMES UNIVERSITY ADVANCED PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

2012-2013

- I. All exams passed at 3 or higher will receive 6 semester units of elective credit with the exception of the Advanced Placement tests in Computer Science A, Micro- and Macro-economics, Comparative Government and Politics, U.S. Government and Politics, Mathematics AB, Physics C Psychology and Statistics. These exams equate to 3 semester units credit each. Students may receive up to 30 units of AP credit.
