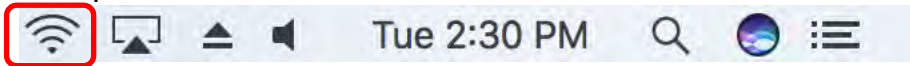


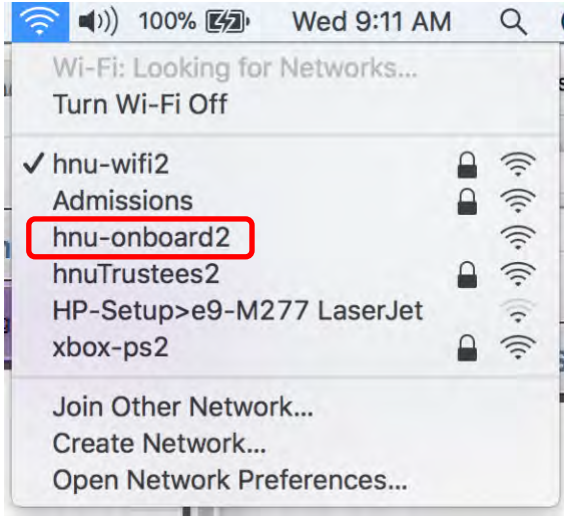
HNU WiFi connection -for Apple Mac

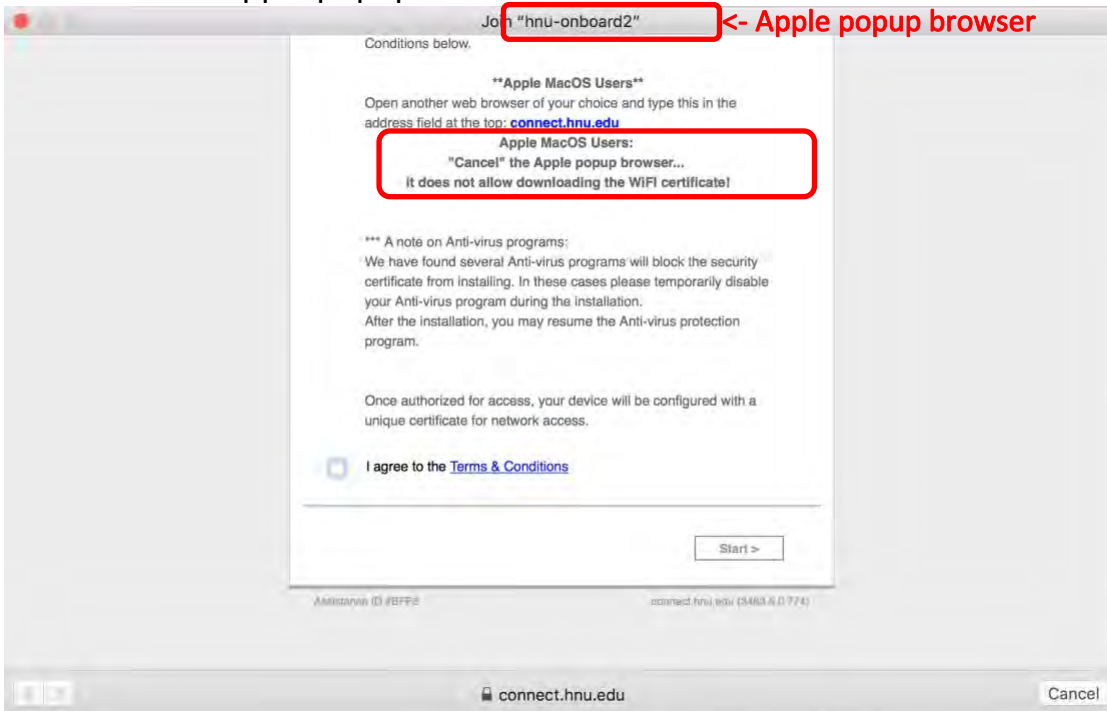
1. Open the WiFi Network Preferences



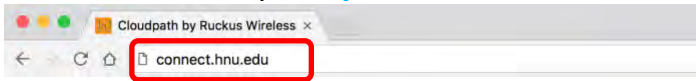
2. Select "hnu-onboard2" or "hnu-onboard"



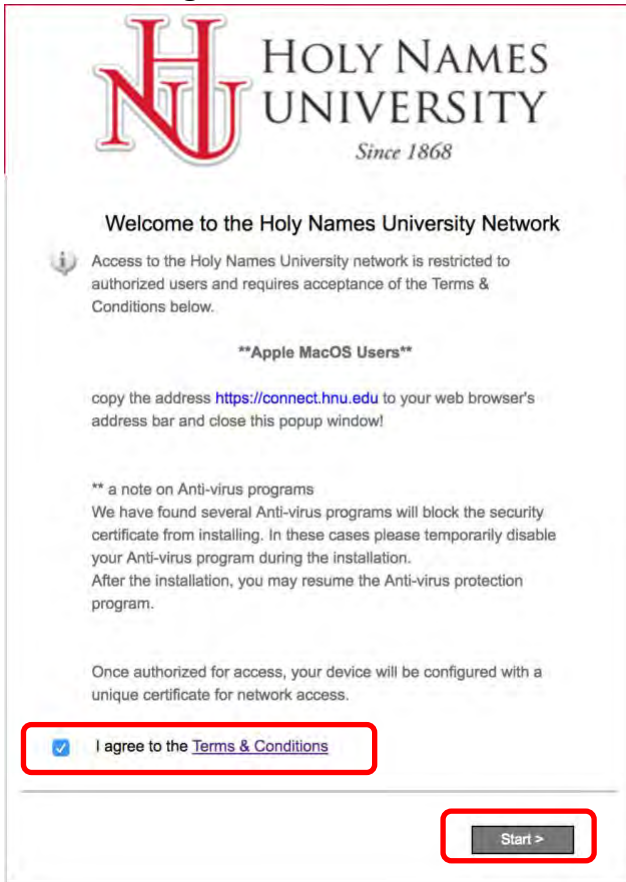
3. Cancel the Apple popup browser



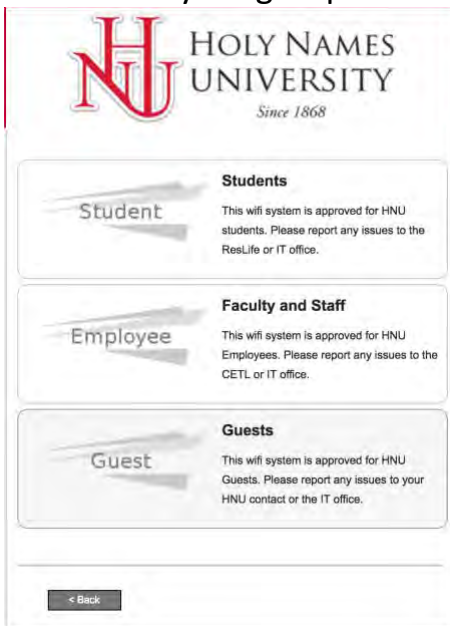
4. Open another browser of your choice (e.g. Chrome, Safari, etc.) and type this is the address field at the top: <https://connect.hnu.edu>



5. Click “I agree...”, then “Start”



6. Click on your group



7. Enter your Username & Password, then click “Continue”

- a. Students Username is your HNU email address, the part before “@my.hnu.edu”
- b. Students Password is your HNU email password
- c. Faculty/Staff Username is your HNU email address, the part before “@hnu.edu”
- d. Faculty/Staff Password is your HNU email password



8. Click on “Laptops or Mobile Devices”




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Laptops or Mobile Devices

Chrome Users: After clicking the link, the file will appear along the bottom of the browser. Click the `hnu-wifi.mobileconfig` file and the profile will open in a separate window. When asked *Install StudentDevices?*, click **Continue**.

Once the profile is installed, use the Airport icon in the top menubar to connect to the "hnu-wifi" network.



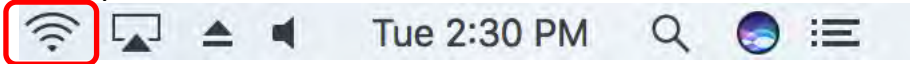
12. Enter you Apple Mac computer User Name and Password



13. The green **Verified** indicates successful installation. Close the "Profiles" page



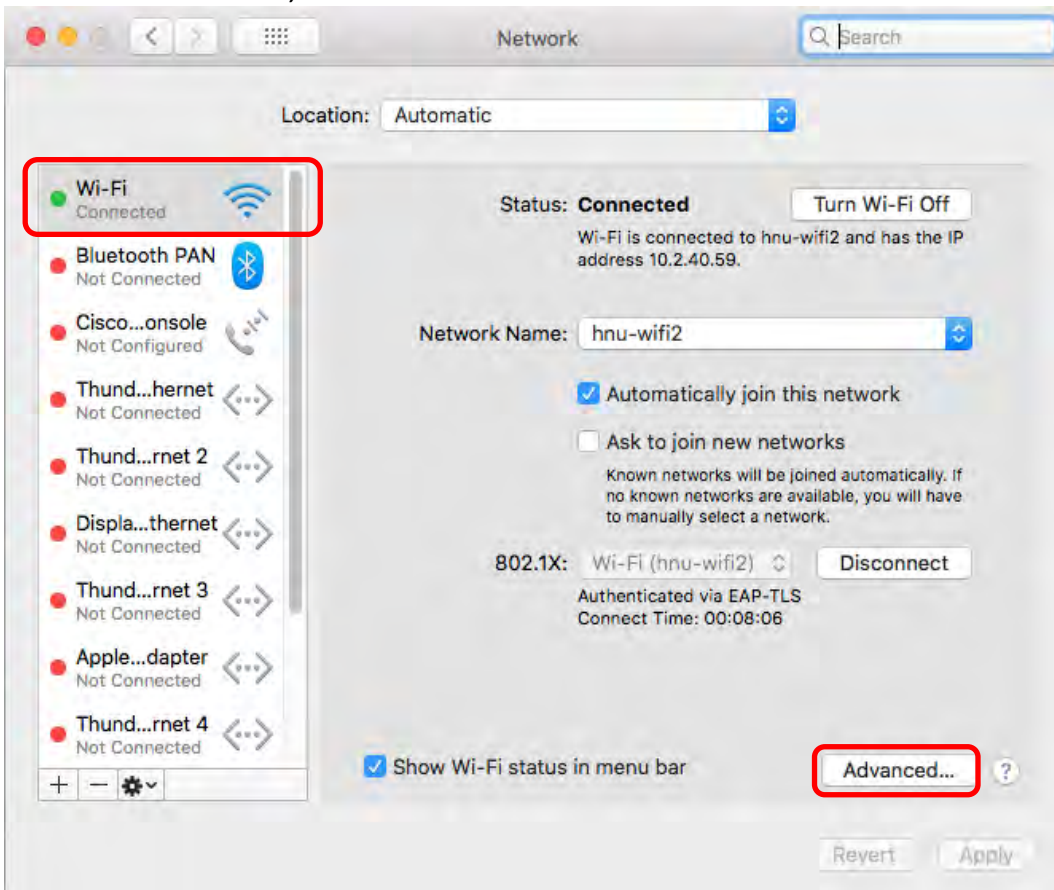
14. Open the WiFi Network Preferences



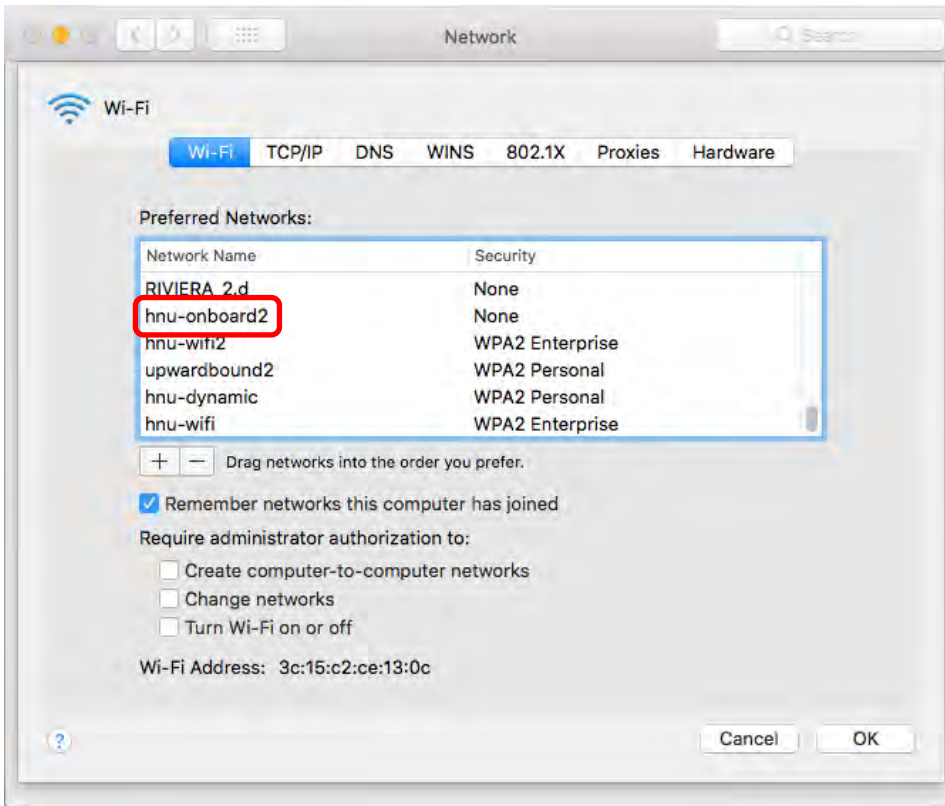
15. Click on "Open Network Preferences"



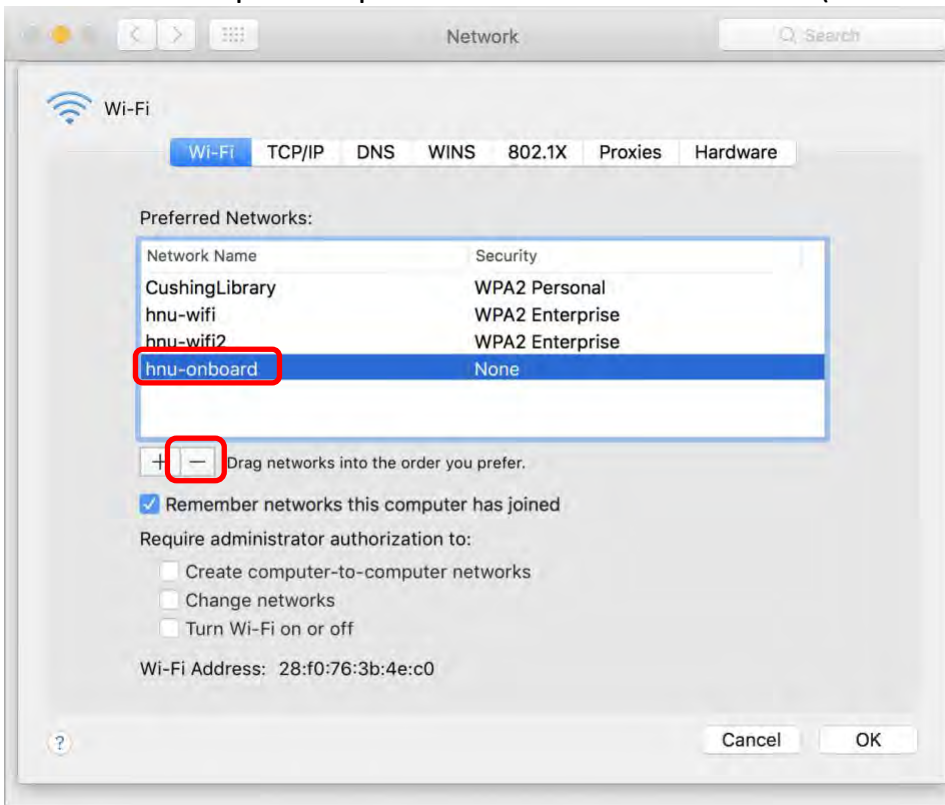
16. Click on "Wi-Fi", then "Advanced"



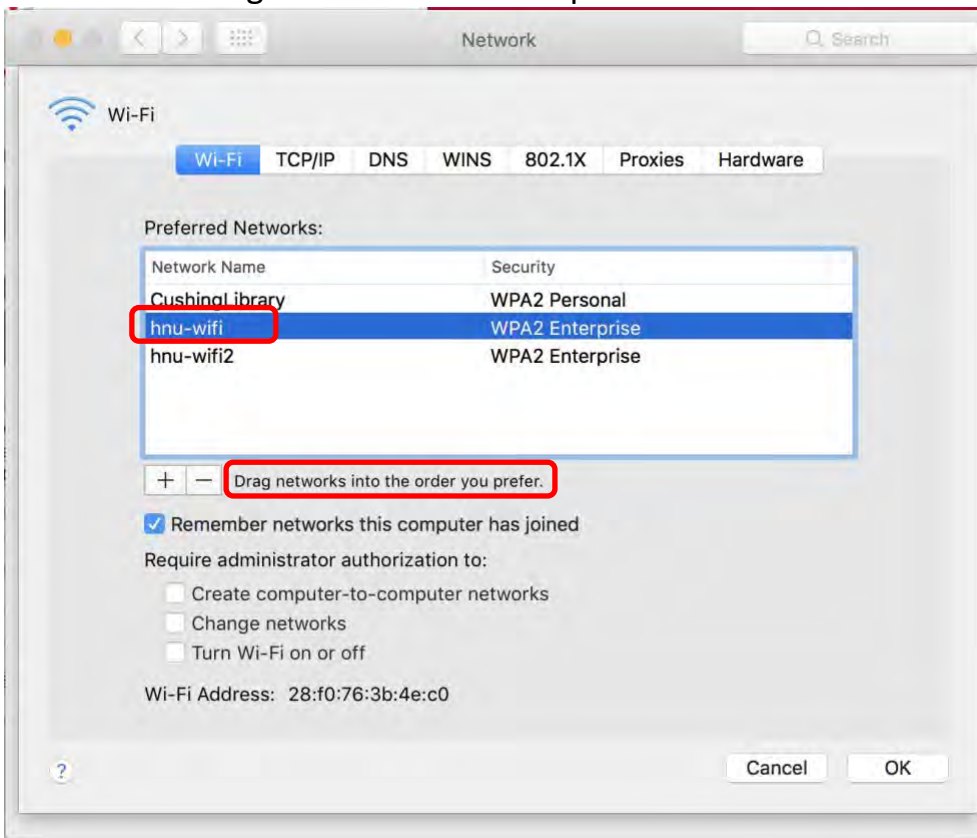
17. Click on "hnu-onboard2"



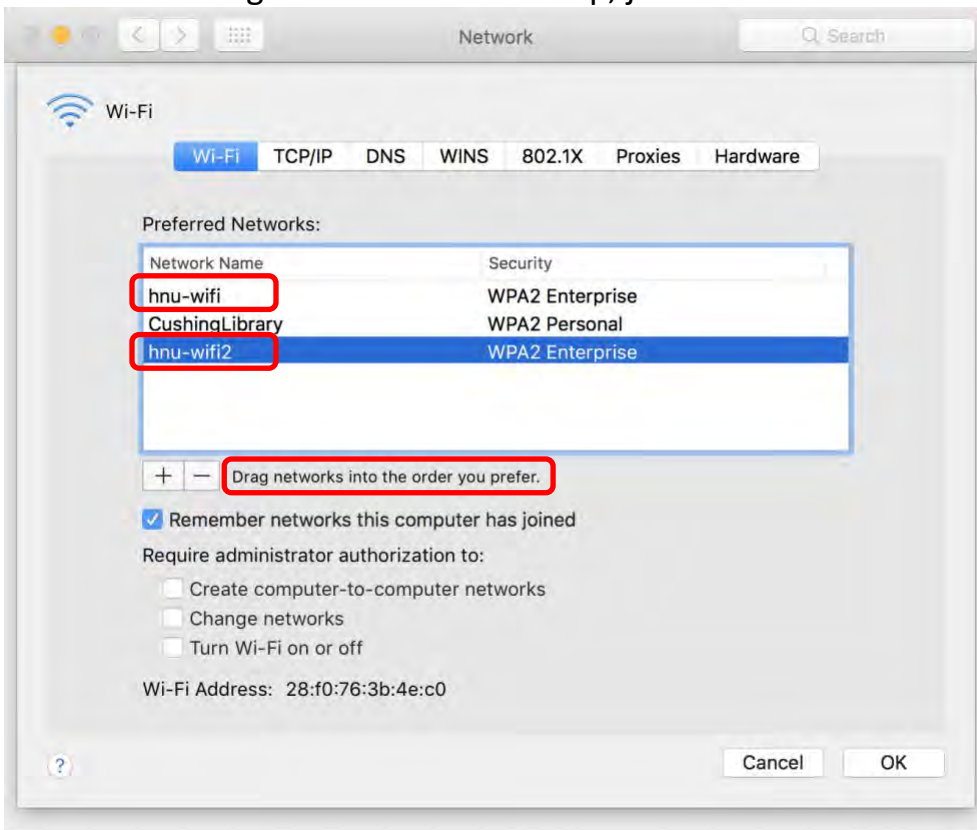
18. Then click on the minus "-" sign to remove "hnu-onboard2" from the list
a. Repeat steps 17 & 18 for "hnu-onboard" (if it's there).



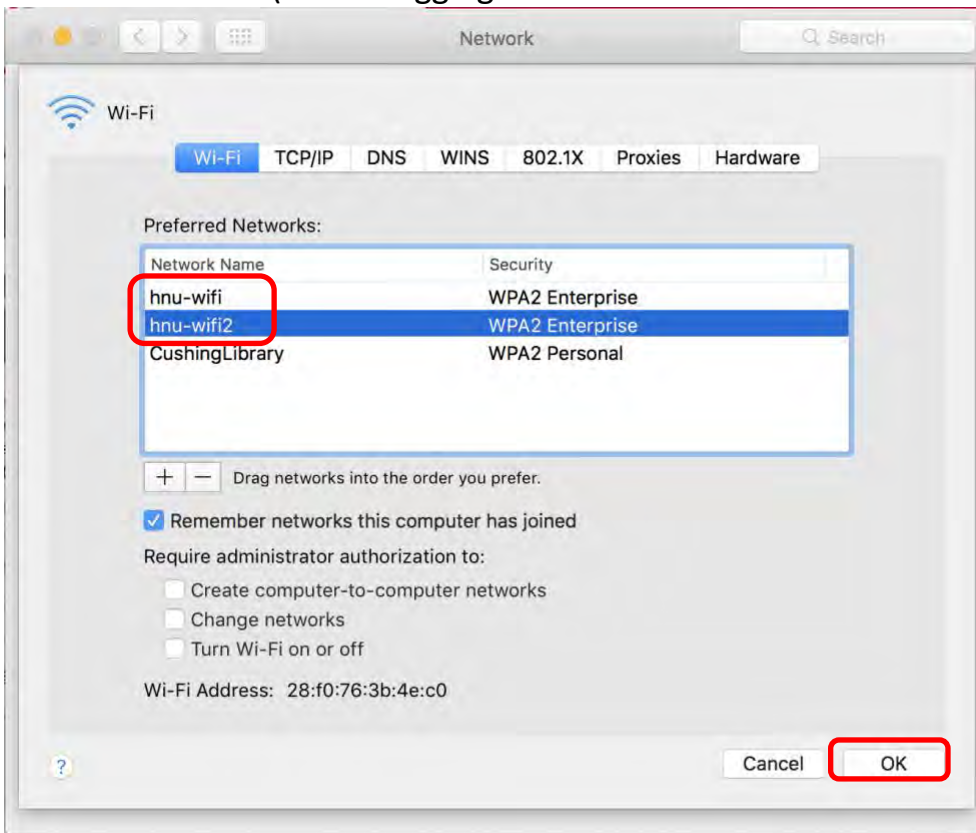
19. Click and drag “hnu-wifi” to the top of the list



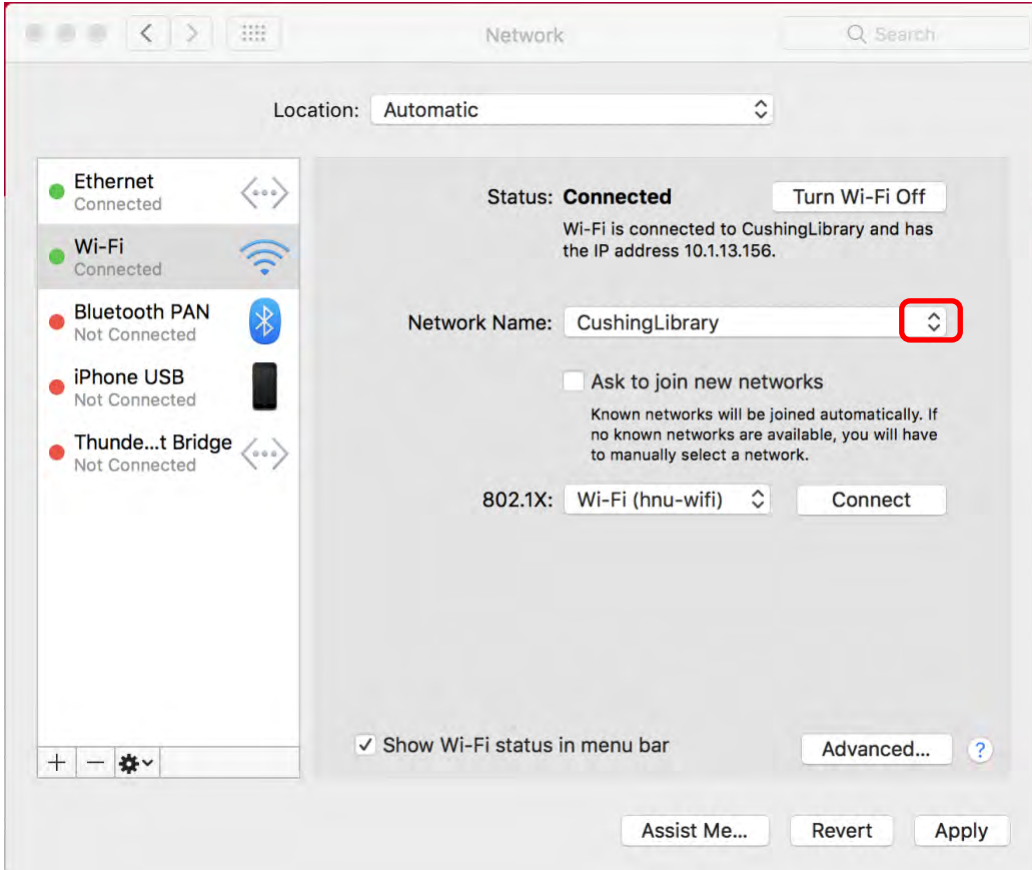
20. Click and drag “hnu-wifi2” to the top, just above “hnu-wifi”



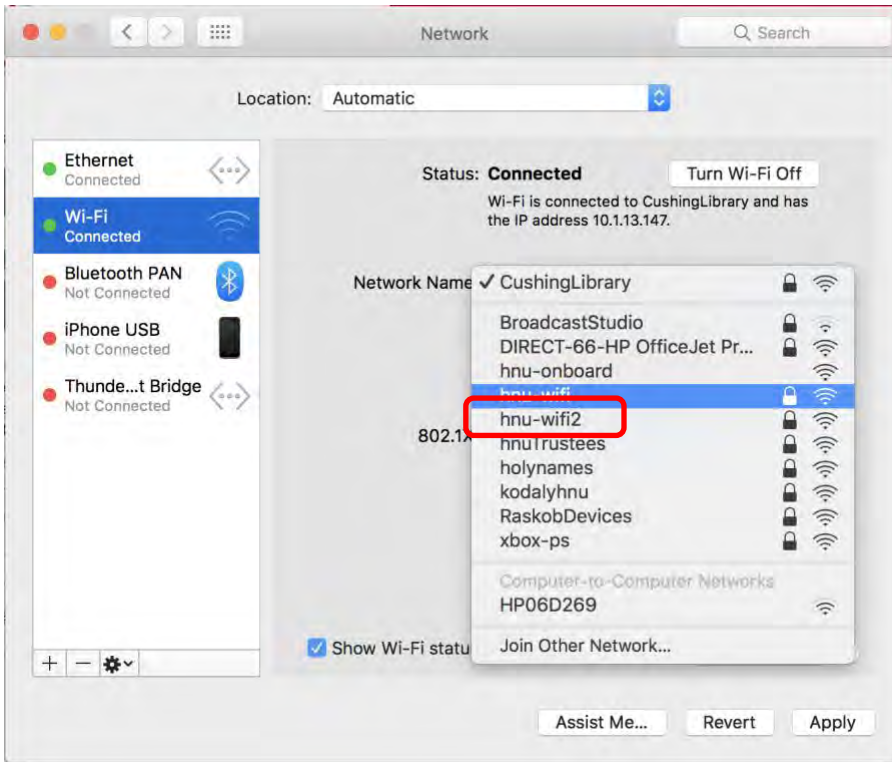
21. Click on “OK” (after dragging “hnu-wifi” & “hnu-wifi2” to the top of the list)



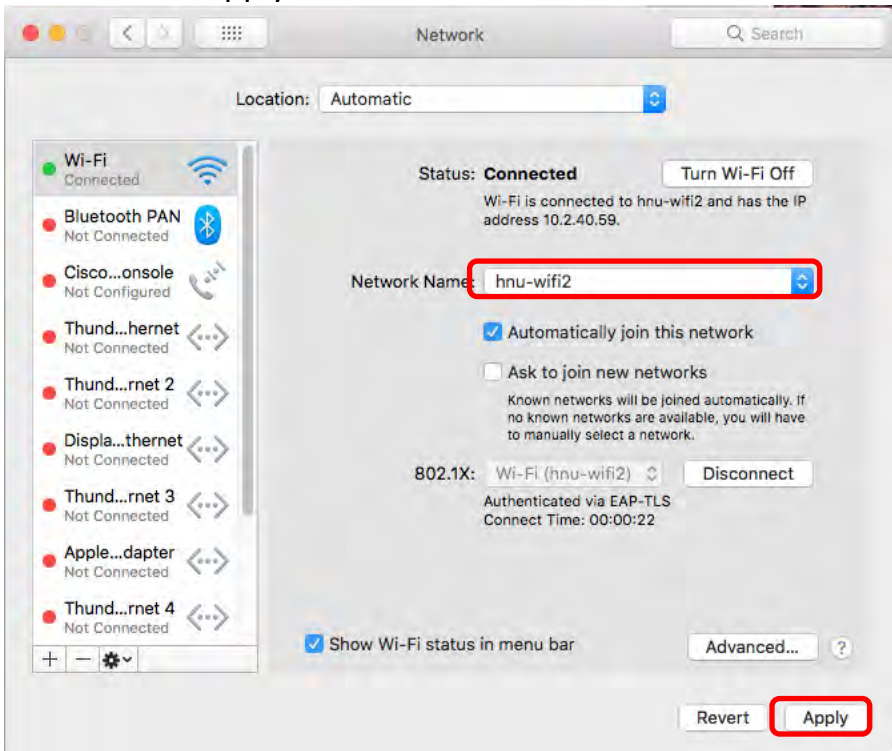
22. Click on the “up/down symbol” for “Network Name”



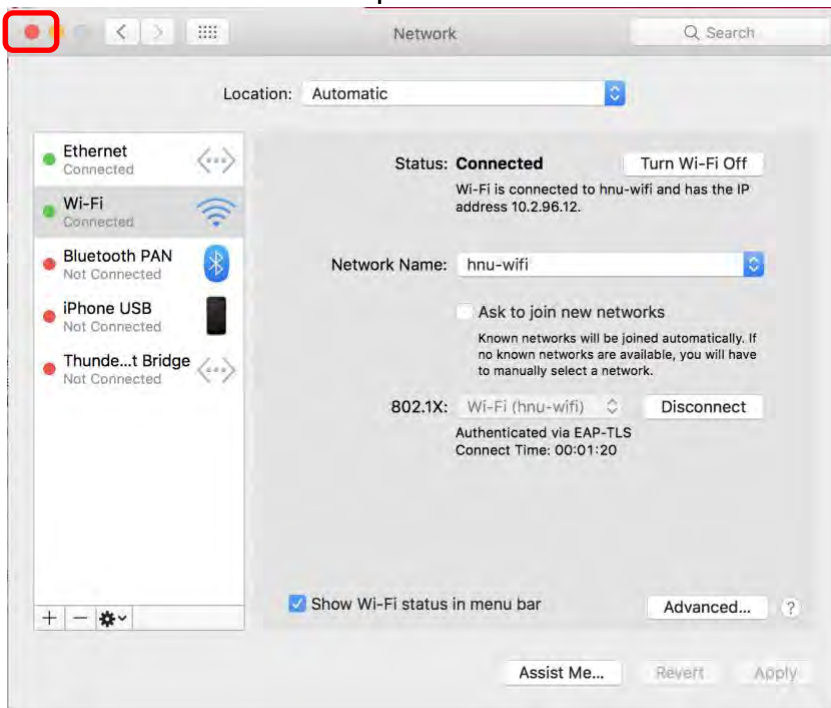
23. Click on "hnu-wifi2"



24. Click on "Apply"



25. Close the “Network” preferences window
