Please sign statement of understanding below:

Non-Matriculated, but qualified students who have a recognized Bachelor's degree may enroll in either undergraduate or graduate courses for personal enrichment or as pre-requisites for a program at Holy Names University or elsewhere. Registration in specific classes requires the approval of the Program Director and the Registrar and as space permits.

Not more than 9 units completed at HNU while in this special post-baccalaureate status may be used towards a graduate degree. Students in this status may enroll in up to a total of 12 units with the understanding that these units cannot be counted toward a subsequent graduate degree.

If a student has been denied admission to Holy Names University, that student is ineligible to take classes in the Special Post-Baccalaureate Status. Financial aid is not available to students in this status.
