HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT

- All appointments will be made through online system: <https://hnuadvising.as.me/>
- Appointments can be in person or via phone

WHAT TO EXPECT

Most first year students have a schedule for fall semester that typically consists of:

- English 1A (General Education - Written Communication Requirement)
- ISAC 1 (General Education - Interdisciplinary Studies Requirement)
- Math Course - You will need to have taken the ALEKS math placement exam to be placed in the correct course (General Education - Mathematical Reasoning Requirement)
- If you have a major declared, you will likely take a major prep course (for example: PSYC 001 for Psychology Majors, BIOL 1A or 1B for Biology Majors, BSAD 011 for Accounting Majors)
- If you are Undecided, your advisor will help you select courses based off your interests
- The rest of your schedule will be filled in with other General Education (GE) courses or electives

Transfer students: Your schedules will be specific to your remaining requirements and transfer coursework

HOW TO PREPARE

- Make sure you've signed up for a Hawk Day and an ALEKS math placement date by visiting www.hnu.edu/hawkday
- You must meet with an advisor before your planned Hawk Day
- Refer to the GE check sheet to get a sense of what GE requirements you might want to explore in the Fall
- You will register for your classes on Hawk Day!
