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



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Holy Names University Enrollment – Fall and Spring Semesters


Fall 2012 to Fall 2019



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HNU Fall Enrollment (Fall Semesters Only)


Fall 2009 to Fall 2019



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HNU Enrollment and Full Time Equivalent (Fall Semesters Only)





Academic Year


