Undergraduate Admissions

- Undergraduate students from HNU may contact the Cal State East Bay Undergraduate Admissions Department at <u>admissionpetitions@csueastbay.edu</u> for assistance with completing an application for the Fall 2023 semester.
- The deadline for undergraduate students to submit an application for Fall 2023 will be extended to March 1, 2023 for applicants who self-identified as transferring from Holy Names. After this date, students may still contact admissionpetitions@csueastbay.edu and may be permitted to apply given there is sufficient time for the application processing and course selection/advising before the start of classes for that semester. Students may be advised to apply for the Spring 2024 semester if there is insufficient time to complete the application process or to submit documents.
- Undergraduate Students who miss the March 1 deadline will have an opportunity to apply for admission for the Spring 2024 semester from August 1, 2023 to August 31, 2023.
- Undergraduate students will be required to meet CSU eligibility requirements: <u>https://www.csueastbay.edu/admissions/transfer-admission-reqs/index.html</u>. Students who are missing one or more of the golden four requirements will be reviewed on a case by case basis and may be granted admission under the provision of completing the outstanding requirement by the end of their first semester.
 - Golden four requirements:
 - Oral Communication (usually 3 semester units): a public speaking course
 - Written Communication (usually 3 semester units): a freshman English composition course
 - Critical Thinking (usually 3 semester units): a logic or argumentation/debate course
 - Math/Quantitative Reasoning (usually 3 semester units): a math course with intermediate algebra as a prerequisite
