



**TCS Consortium – Pacific Oaks College Transfer Agreement**

*This information has been condensed from the official memorandum of understanding.*

**A. Eligible Programs**

The following chart lists the HNU Programs available for teach-out at Pacific Oaks College and the location options for Eligible HNU Students to complete the teach-out of their programs at Pacific Oaks College:

- B. **Qualifying Criteria.** To qualify for the teach-out of their program at Pacific Oaks College (and be considered an “Eligible HNU Student”), HNU students must provide a transcript or other acceptable form of evidence from HNU of active enrollment status and good academic standing through the Spring 2023 term in one of the HNU programs listed in Section II.A. HNU students who are not in good academic standing or who cannot provide proof they were in good academic standing under HNU’s academic policies will be reviewed for admission by Pacific Oaks College’s academic program admissions committee. Former HNU students and HNU students who are on a leave of absence shall be approved for eligibility based on an individual review by Pacific Oaks College’s academic program admissions committee. In all instances Pacific Oaks College’s decision is final and not appealable.
- C. **Application Fees.** Pacific Oaks College will waive admission application fees for HNU students applying to Pacific Oaks College under this Agreement.
- D. **Admission.** Pacific Oaks College shall pre-approve admission of all Eligible HNU Students.
- E. **Enrollment.** Eligible HNU Students admitted to and enrolled with Pacific Oaks College (“HNU Transfer Students”) shall be subject to all Pacific Oaks College policies, procedures, codes of conduct, and requirements as provided for in the Pacific Oaks College Student Handbook and



Academic Catalog currently in effect (“Pacific Oaks College Handbook and Catalog”). Students enrolling at Pacific Oaks College under this Agreement will be required to meet Pacific Oaks College’s satisfactory academic progress requirements as published the Pacific Oaks College Handbook and Catalog.

- F. **Terms.** The Agreement will become effective and commence upon the signature of HNU and Pacific Oaks College and the approval of WSCUC (the “Effective Date”). Eligible HNU Students shall be able to enroll at Pacific Oaks College within a period of three (3) academic semesters (Summer 2023, Fall 2023 and Spring 2024).
- G. **Transfer Credit.** Pacific Oaks College will accept all earned credits based on HNU’s degree completion audit or official transcripts. If a degree audit or official transcript is not available, Pacific Oaks College will conduct an audit based on an unofficial transcript or other documentation provided by the Eligible HNU Student. Determination of requirement fulfillment in the latter case is at the sole discretion of Pacific Oaks College and not appealable. Pacific Oaks College will suspend residency requirements (i.e. requirement to take a minimum number of credits from Pacific Oaks College) for HNU students transferring to Pacific Oaks College under this Agreement.
- H. **Tuition.** Tuition charged to HNU Transfer Students by TCSPP for the 2022-2023 Academic Year shall be at the rate per credit hour provided in the table below for the applicable program. Tuition shall be subject to annual increases as determined by TCSPP each year for all TCSPP programs. In each case the rate was chosen because it was the lower of the two rates published by TCSPP and HNU for the applicable program. All HNU Transfer Students will pay the fees as published in the most current TCSPP Handbook and Catalog. This pay structure will be adhered to for three (3) years for undergraduate programs and two (2) years for Masters programs. After these timeframes, the tuition structure will be re-assessed by TCSPP and a determination will be made if it will continue forward for remaining students.

- I. **Financial Aid.** Students seeking financial aid will be required to complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at least four weeks prior to the start of their first term using Pacific Oaks College's School Code: 001255. Students seeking to renew their financial aid award will be required to follow the requirements outlined in Pacific Oaks College's published academic catalog at the time they are seeking renewal. Students will follow the financial aid appeals process outlined in Pacific Oaks College's published academic catalog at the time they are seeking to engage in the appeals process.
