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Information for Holy Names University Undergraduate Students

The University of San Francisco (USF) asks that all Holy Names University (HNU) undergraduate students interested in transferring to USF please contact Admissions Counselor Arnoldo Valdivieso Martinez at avaldiviesomartinez@usfca.edu.

The University of San Francisco will waive the following requirements for Holy Names University undergraduate students who enter Fall 2023 as part of USF's existing transfer process:

- 1 of 3 Residency Requirements: HNU transfer students included in this agreement do not need to complete at least 44 units at the University of San Francisco. Students will need to complete 16 hours of upper division work in their major and 30 unit hours at USF. The 16 hours of upper division may count towards the 30 unit hours total. Additional information on this requirement is provided in detail below.
- There is no limit to the number of courses that may be transferred to USF.
- HNU students do not have to take their Community-Engaged Learning (CEL) course at USF.
- HNU students do not have to meet the language requirement of their school or major.

The University of San Francisco will substitute the following requirements for Holy Names University undergraduate students who enter Fall 2023 as part of USF's existing transfer process:

- Students will be allowed to complete their degree requirements by following the core courses and graduation requirements as outlined in the USF-HNU Crosswalk (please see below). USF will be adding courses to this crosswalk and will be looking for courses that can transfer to reduce the number of courses a transfer student needs to complete or re-take.
- HNU Writing Across the Curriculum course will meet the USF requirement that A2. Rhetoric and Composition must be taken at USF.

Holy Names University undergraduate students will need complete the following requirements during and after transferring to USF:

- Complete a total 128 units, applying the waivers and substitutions listed above. Every effort will be made to assist UHN students in maximizing the number of transfer credits accepted.
- Complete 44 Core Curriculum units (please see the USF-HNU Crosswalk below).
- Meet major GPA requirements. Students must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher and be in good academic standing at HNU, which means having a 2.0 or higher GPA in the most recent term in college.
- Meet the published requirements, including unit requirements, for a particular major(s) and for the school or college offering the major as described in the USF Catalog. Advisors will be working with HNU students to help them find courses that can transfer and substitute for requirements. Please note that students who major in Nursing must attain a 2.0 (C) or better in each required support course for the major and each nursing course, and Business majors must maintain a 2.0 (C) or better in both business core and major courses.
- Meet 2 of the 3 Residency Requirements:
 - Satisfactorily complete their last 30 units at USF. If a student is in their last semester at HNU, they should contact the Admissions counselor to discuss their needs.
 - Satisfactorily complete a minimum of 16 upper division unit hours in their major at USF. These 16 unit hours may be part of the last 30 unit hours required at USF. Students in the McLaren School of Management should refer to the Management section of this catalog for additional guidelines and policies.
- International Students enrolled at HNU may be required to complete additional documentation to transfer their international student status from HNU to USF in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS). Additionally, international Students must remain full-time to meet visa requirements.
